

**Saint Mark's Registered Students:**

Here is the information you need for: picking up your UBC library card, getting a UBC Library card login and picking up your SMC library card

UBC Library cards allow borrowing privileges at all UBC libraries as well as access to UBC online resources. To view the catalogue, go to the [UBC Library homepage](#).

Saint Mark's College library cards allow access to the consortium of Theological colleges on UBC campus including: Saint Mark's, the Vancouver School of Theology, Regent College and Carey Theological School. Your library card allows borrowing of up to 40 items across the consortium at any time. To view our catalogue, THEOLOG, please see the library homepages from either the [Saint Mark's](#) or [Corpus Christi](#) websites. To get your SMC library card, please come by the library during open hours and staff will set you up an account.

How to Get your UBC Library Card


You will need to pick up your UBC library card in person at the UBC Carding office, inside the UBC Bookstore:

1. Staff will check your name from our SMC and CCC lists. Your name is on this list.
- ➔ 2. Once you have your card, you need to reset your PIN: ***At this stage, students do not have PIN numbers, but this is our work-around as affiliates of UBC.** Your PIN is essentially a password that combines with your library barcode to access UBC library resources.
3. You can re-set your PIN online: once you have your card with its library barcode number:
 - a. Click [here](#) to access borrowing services
 - b. At the bottom of the page, you will see a Standard Library login box: click on the link, **Forgot your PIN?**

CWL Library Login

To log into the Library Catalogue using the UBC Campus-Wide Login (CWL) facility, click the **CWL Login** icon.
